Template & Instructions

***Request are due by March 27 2026 (Earlier submissions encouraged when possible)**

1. Program administrators will receive an email from the GME containing instructions and a link to the folder
 - a. If you do not receive the email, please reach out to GME
 - i. GME-OfficeStaffdl@caregroup.harvard.edu
2. Please review **pages 3-5** on how to fill out the file.
3. New hire intake files that are ready for GME to review need to be upload to the folder labelled as “**1. New Hire Submission**”
 - a. **Program administrators will upload**
 - b. Please keep them as an **excel sheet**
 - c. **GME will review between 1-2 days**
 - d. **Please do not email new hire intake files to GME**




4. New hire intake files that have been reviewed by GME will be found under the folder labelled as **“2. New hire processed”**.

5. New hire intake file edits by program administrators:
 - a. If changes to the original file submission are needed, program administrators will need to request access to the file found in **“2. Advancement processed”**
 - b. Select your **File in folder labelled “2. Advancement processed”**, and then select **“Request more access”** found on the top right corner GME will unlock the file as requested
